ORDER:

In the G.O. 1st read above, Government have issued orders declaring **24.09.2015 (Thursday)** as Holiday on the occasion of **Bakrid(Id-UI-Azha)** under Negotiable Instrument Act 1881.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Chief Executive Officer, Andhra Pradesh State Wakf Board, Hyderabad has requested to declare **25.09.2015 (Friday)** instead of **24.09.2015 (Thursday)** as Holiday on the occasion of **Bakrid(Id-UI-Azha)** as per moon sight.

The Government, after careful consideration of the matter, have decided to change the Holiday on the occasion of **Bakrid(Id-UI-Azha)** on **25.09.2015 (Friday)** instead of 24.09.2015 (Thursday) under the Explanation to Section 25 of the Negotiable Instruments Act, 1881 (Central Act XXVI of 1881).
